Roundtable Updates:

-<u>Betty McCracken (James River Soil and Water Conservation District)</u>: MJRT Brochure has been completed, but very expensive (98 cents each). Will save them for the annual meeting

- -JRSWCD paid for the printing, so will count as match to the grant
- -Gay Stokes will have some printed by the Richmond offices too
- -Cynthia Scheuermann (Department of Forestry): Just completed a Missouri gravel bed installation to store trees and develop strong root systems, for installation on Belle Isle and similar places to combat invasivies
  - -Tree Lab is offering free trees and shrubs for Richmond City residences (as an FYI)
- -Katie Ranger (DEQ, non-point source): No Update
- -Liz Chudoba (Alliance for the Chesapeake): Grant funding has closed for the Reduce your Stormwater Program. Had provided funds for stormwater BMPs in Charlottesville and Greater Richmond area. Looking for funding to continue the program and the reduce your stormwater online tool. Are now turning their focus to Churchill neighborhood to increase parks and community space. Will be expanding monitoring programs in the Piedmont (Chesapeake Monitoring Cooperative report demonstrated that there is a need to expand monitoring in this region). Once promotional materials are put together, information will be sent to MJRT for the newsletter

Katie: DEQ is updating their monitoring equipment, so the old equipment can be donated to community organizations. Both Liz Chudoba and Lorne Field are interested in the equipment.

<u>-Lorne Field (Chesterfield County)</u>: Spring Run Elementary School may be the site of the next rain garden, have some final details to finish up. Internally, environmental engineering and education programming is rebranding to give it a unique identity. This includes a new website! Will take at least a year, hopefully sooner to help fulfill some permit requirements. Have also done storm drain art on 24 drop inlets in a day at libraries!

-<u>Chris Gyurisin (City of Lynchburg)</u>: Working more in schools; working to recruit volunteers to help with this program. Have also completed several stream restoration projects, and the community is responding positively to these projects.

Kate Carney (CVWMA Outreach and Education Specialist): Newly hired!!

Nancy Drumheller (CVWMA): Launched a customer service survey, and wants feedback. All MJRT steering committee, please send out and spread the word!

- -Lindsey's List: Great way to advertise this message to apartments
- -Runs through November 15th
- -Data will be available in the CVWMA website
- -Good Morning RVA is also a very strong advertising tool

Gay Stokes (City of Richmond): New MS4 report is available online

(Richmond.gov>stormwater>regulations). Will be continuing rain barrel deliveries. Has expanded work with seniors including the  $9^{th}$  district health fair and AARP.

Olivia Hall (Henrico County): Have also done the stormwater art on four drop inlets. Bark in the Park is Saturday, 10/7 and Olivia will be hosting a table.
