## It is an area of land on which all water flows to a common place.

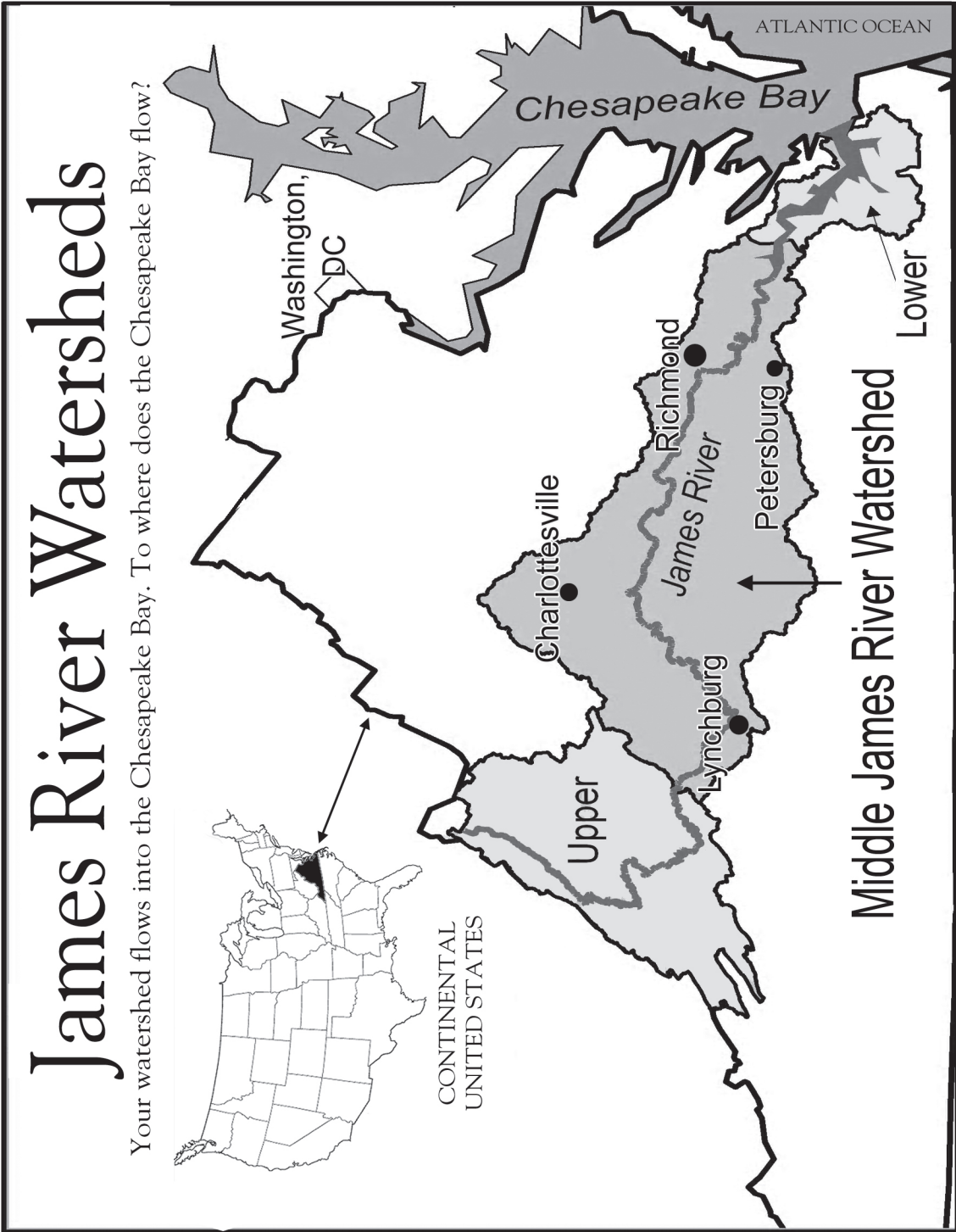
